



**Concrete Restoration**

**Technical Bulletin 0101**



*Originally we were called into this job to remove graffiti from a wooden paling fence. While removing the graffiti, we were also asked if we could clean the concrete driveway. Using water under pressure, our Surface Restoration Technician was able to remove rubber tyre marks, oil stains, moss and algae from the pores of the concrete surface, restoring it back to its original condition without any substrate damage or cleaning marks visible at the completion of the job.*

*As you can see in the pictures, there is a substantial difference between the before and after pictures. The customer didn't realise how dirty concrete got until we cleaned it and they saw the difference.*

*The Surface Restoration Vehicles we use are fully fitted with everything we need to perform our tasks; not only do we carry 1000litres of water which gives us access to jobs in remote areas but we also have generators which provide us with power and boiler units that allow us to use hot steam to get rid of chewing gum, bill posters and paint coatings.*

*In all, a one stop shop for all graffiti and cleaning problems.*
